Other Information:

- All students will wear a BCA PE uniform ordered by the school. The charge will be placed on your account.
- A BCA shirt will be ordered for your student to wear on Tuesdays and Thursdays.

BCA will provide each student with an iPad Pro, Apple Pencil, and iPad keyboard, complete with Microsoft Office, to use for 21st century learning. The technology is valued at over \$1000 per student. All items are owned by BCA and will be rented by the student for a security deposit of \$50. The deposit will be returned in the form of a credit towards next year's re-enrollment fee upon the return of the iPad Pro, Apple Pencil, and keyboard, in excellent condition. If any of these items are not returned in excellent condition, the student will be responsible for replacing any damaged parts before report cards and transcripts will be released. Students may check-out the same iPad Pro the following year upon request.
